#### Privacy Notice - Data Protection Act 1998

We **Icknield Infant & Nursery School** are a data controller for the purposes of the Data Protection Act. We collect information from you and may receive information about your child/children from previous schools and the Learning Records Service where applicable. We hold this personal data and use it to:

- Support pupil teaching and learning;
- Monitor and report on pupil progress;
- Provide appropriate pastoral care, and
- Assess how well the school is doing.

This information includes your child/children's contact details, national curriculum assessment results, attendance information<sup>1</sup> and personal characteristics such as ethnic group, special educational needs and any relevant medical information.

**We will not give information about your child/children to anyone outside the school without your consent unless the law and our rules allow us to.**

We are required by law to pass some of your information to the Local Authority and the Department for Education (DfE)
